Therapy Services

Summa Wadsworth-Rittman Hospital's Therapy Services Department provides services for both inpatient and outpatients. Services include:

- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Speech therapy
- Athletic training
- Aquatic therapy
- Fall prevention and balance therapy
- Functional Capacity Evaluation, to help determine when you're able to return to work
- Lymphedema treatment
- Women's health therapy, which may include treatment for incontinence, prenatal and postpartum rehab, osteoporosis or recovery following breast surgery.

Physical therapy services for outpatients are provided on Mondays from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., Tuesdays and Fridays from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., Wednesdays and Thursdays from 7:30 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Occupational and speech therapies are provided for outpatients by appointment.

Employee Parking Policy

There have been some modifications to the employee parking policy. Please note these changes and important key points of the policy as follows:

- All employees authorized to park in Summa Health System parking lots or decks must display a current parking permit (**RED** sticker) which may be obtained from the Protective Services Office. The permit must be visibly displayed on the back of the rearview mirror.
- All Employees are expected to park in-between the marked **white lines**.

The marked yellow lines are reserved for patients, visitors and guests only.

- **Summa Barberton Hospital:**

Employees may park on the surface parking lot located east of the Parking deck, as well as in the parking deck when space is available. **Employees must park in spaces with marked white lines.** The marked yellow lines are reserved for patients, visitors and guests only.

- Employees are to enter and exit the parking deck at the entrance/exit located at the southeast corner of the parking deck on Paige Street. Employees are not permitted to enter the parking deck at the Medical Office Building entrance located at the northwest corner of the parking deck.

Restrictive Parking: Employees may not park in the areas marked for the Parkview Center, Patient/Visitor Parking, Valet Parking, Handicapped parking or any other restricted area. Employees are not to park in a handicapped space unless the vehicle displays a Handicapped license plate or state-issued placard issued for use by that employee.

- **Summa Wadsworth-Rittman Hospital:** Restricted-area parking is located near the Maintenance Building, the Loading and Unloading Zones, the Physical Therapy Department, the Physicians Parking area, and any area designated as patient/visitor parking or marked with yellow lines.
- An employee who receives a vehicle citation for an offense will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with Policy #9.1, Disciplinary Process and Rules of Conduct. A copy of the Security incident report describing the violation will be forwarded to the employee's department head.

The hospital does not assume any responsibility for theft or damage to vehicles on hospital property. Any Parking inquiries or concerns should be directed to Parking Department at 330-375-3295.
